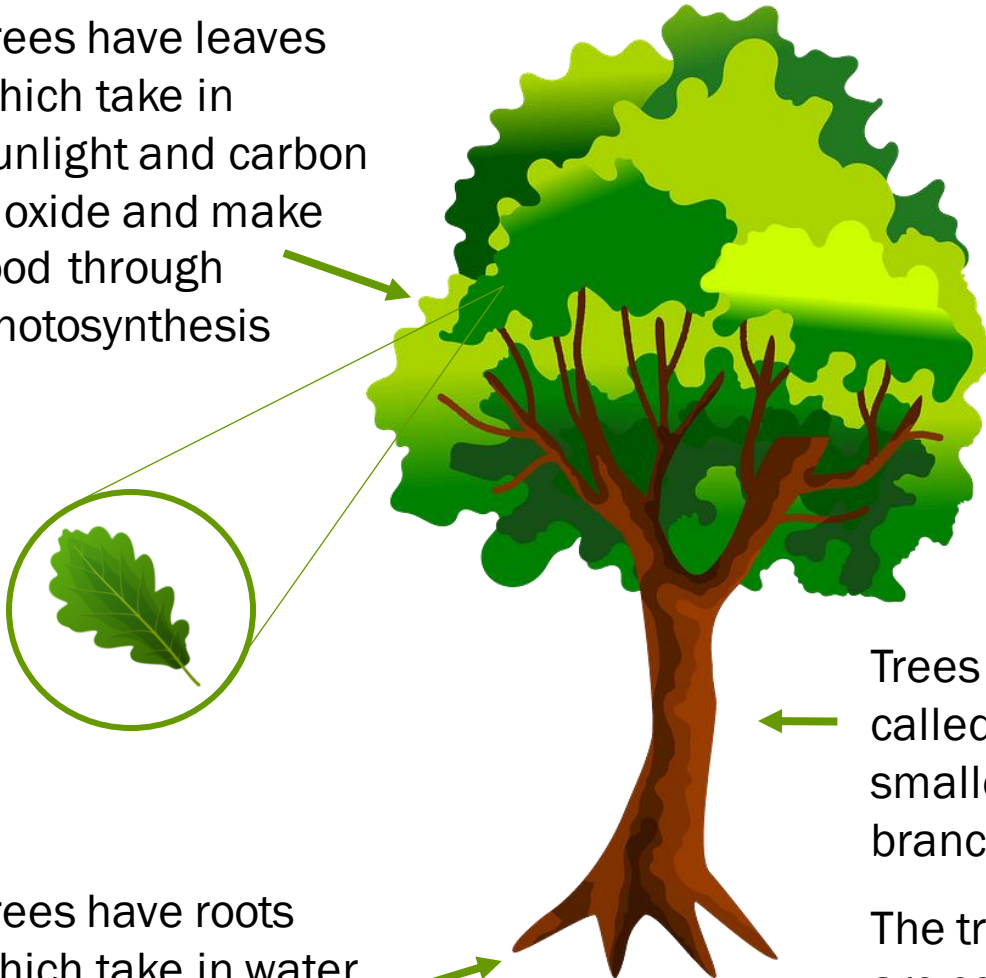


What is a tree?

Trees are a type of plant. There are around 73, 000 different species of tree on Earth that we know of!

Trees have leaves which take in sunlight and carbon dioxide and make food through photosynthesis



Trees have roots which take in water and nutrients from the soil

Trees have a main stem called a trunk, and smaller stems called branches

The trunk and branches are covered in hard bark for protection



Broadleaved trees have flowers for reproduction – if the flowers are pollinated, they grow seeds

Conifers are trees that reproduce using cones. Male cones make pollen and female cones grow seeds
